- April 20: Last day to register to vote for the primary
- May 6–8 (Wed–Fri) & May 11–13 (Mon–Wed): Excused, in-person absentee voting*
- May 14–16: In-person, no-excuse absentee voting
- May 19: Primary Election Day • Polls open 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- Sept. 19 – Oct. 20: Online mail-in absentee request portal open
- Oct. 5: Last day to register to vote for the general election
